

have a safe crime-free christmas

Please Pass This On To All our NHW Readers

Christmas is a time for giving, but it's also a time for taking.

The darker nights, social occasions and gift buying mean there are plenty of opportunities for criminals. But there are steps you can take to keep yourself from becoming a victim.

At Home.

Don't leave Christmas presents under your tree if they are in view from your windows or doors. Ensure windows and doors are locked at all times.

<u>Be mindful of what you post on social media.</u> Don't advertise that you have expensive gifts or that you're out for a meal or visiting relatives. Criminals like to know when a house is empty. Make your house look occupied if you're not at home.

<u>Invest in a timer to turn your lights on. A TV simulator can give the illusion that light signals are being emitted from a TV, so it looks as though you are there watching.</u> Leave a radio on.

Get a neighbour to open and close your curtains, put your bins in and out and remove post from your letterbox. <u>Dispose of boxes and rubbish discreetly.</u> Leaving branded packaging outside will alert criminals to the fact that you have new and valuable items in the house.

Vehicle Security.

Make sure nothing is left on display in your car. Even small items are tempting to a thief Try to avoid going back to your car to leave presents part-way through your shopping.

If you have to, put all presents in the boot and ensure your car is locked.

Car crime accounts for more than a quarter of all reported crime in the UK, so <u>make</u>

<u>sure all windows are closed and doors locked every time you leave it</u>, even for very short periods of time.

<u>Never leave your keys in the ignition whilst your vehicle is unattended, even when defrosting windows.</u>

<u>Every winter many cars are stolen like this, even when on your own drive or right outside your house.</u>



Keep Watching, and remember, being 'nosey' in our NHW Group is NOT a crime!!

Personal Safety.

When Christmas shopping be aware of what you are carrying. Mobiles and digital devices mean you are an ideal target for thieves. Keep your bank cards in a safe RFID case & zipped inside a bag or internal pocket. Pickpockets thrive in a bustling shopping environment. That person who bumped into you may just be one. It only takes a few seconds for an experienced thief to steal from you.

Consider getting a personal safety alarm if you are out alone and plan a well-lit, busy route home.

Minder TV simulator.

As a Burglar Deterrent Device it simulates that someone is at home to deter any potential burglar with the coloured lights and movement of a TV.

Battery operated lightweight and portable. Simple on/off switch for instant use. Requires 3 x AA batteries.

The Simulated TV Mk3 version that has 12 multi-coloured LED's, mains operated with 4.5dc adapter, a 3-setting choice of on Permanently, 4 hours or 7 hours from dusk to dawn. Now only £15.00 ea.



Purse Bells

Just clip it to your purse, and the bells will 'tinkle' as a warning if anyone tries to steal your purse.

Available in a limited range of colours.



The Tip Top wall / fence spikes.

There designed to cause maximum discomfort with minimum harm, as opposed to barbed wire etc, by helping to prevent intruders gaining access over walls and fences. Each strip measures 450 x 50mm.



Battery operated Spotlight.

Comes with built-in PIR detector with 2 LED's and can be attached almost anywhere.

Motion activated with a 300 lumen output.

Turns off after 20 seconds unless movement is still detected. 160 degree vision and 37 sq mtr of coverage. Weatherproof to IP66 rating. Triggers from dusk 'till dawn

Requires 4 x D cell batteries.



24hr Plug-In Timers.

A plug-in timer is a great security device so you select when electrical items are turned on giving the impression of an occupied home, when you are out. Has 96 on/off settings over 24hrs, manual override and can be switched on for 15 minute intervals.





RFID protection card/wallets.

Were you aware that every time you walk near a contactless card reader that a criminal could create, or in a store or petrol station (for example) it COULD remotely read your card without you knowing?

RFID Protection 'Platinum' card (top) prevents unauthorized remote use of numerous contactless cards by just keeping one of these in your purse or wallet with your credit or debit cards.

Keyring Torch Alarm.



The siren alarm will sound for 20 seconds after the first phone number has been dialed.


Alternatively the alarm can be switched off for silent alert.
